

Life Centered Education (LCE) Training Offerings

CEC offers two options for training on the Life Centered Education (LCE) transition curriculum.

WEB BASED

- 90 minutes
- Led by experienced LCE users
- Phone consultation by trainer in advance of training
- No limit on the number of users participating

Technology required: Access to the Internet.

Cost: \$950

IN PERSON

- All day, typical session 6 hours
- Led by experienced LCE users
- Phone consultation by trainer in advance of training
- Max of 40 participants

Technology required: Projector, screen, access to the Internet, and participants should ideally be able to access a computer each for practice sessions.

Cost: \$4000 plus trainer travel and expenses
